Vocational Scholarship Student Application Instructions

Application Guidelines

You must use the Vocational Scholarship Application form. It must be dated and signed by you and your parent(s) or guardian. Typewritten applications are preferred over handwritten submissions. Applications and all supporting documents must be in English or English translations.

Completed Application

Your application must be in a **3-hole paper folder**. Elaborate bindings, clear plastic, and bulky coverings are discouraged. Do not include the instructional pages in your submission.

Employment

List jobs held and community service performed from November 1, 2015, through the current date. Please list total hours worked, not average hours per week. You will receive 0 points in this section if you do not list your hours as instructed.

Transcript and Qualification Scores

Include official, complete, current high school transcript of student grades. Transcript may be a photocopy that bears the original signature of the proper school authority. Also include official results or copies of required vocational school qualification scores. **It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the scores are listed on the sealed transcript.**

Letter of Recommendation

Include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, employer, or responsible community member. The letter may cover your abilities, work habits, leadership, personality, and integrity. Emphasize your qualities for the desired vocational training.

The letter may be original or photocopy and must be limited to one side of a single sheet (8.5-by-11-inch) of paper, typed, **dated and signed by the author.**

Exhibits

Attach copies of exhibits of achievements in vocational achievements, scholarship, leadership, athletics, dramatics, community service, or other activities, but avoid repetition. Examples of exhibits include newspaper articles featuring the applicant or letters of commendation.

Custodial Parent

If your parents are divorced or separated, answer the questions for the parent you lived with the most in the past 12 months. If you lived with both parents an equal number of days in the past 12 months, you would count the parent who provided you with the greatest amount of support, financial as well as material. Material things would include cars, clothing, medical and dental payments, etc. If that parent has remarried, you must include that stepparent's information. **Note:** If the family has divorced or separated within the past five years and the custodial parent has not remarried, you must provide the financial information of the non-custodial parent.

Independent Student

We will not accept an applicant as an independent student unless the student has graduated from high school and is not living with a Custodial parent or guardian.
